GSI is working with the Smithsonian Institute's Office of Facilities Engineering & Operations (OFEO), Office of Facilities Reliability as a sub-contractor to Facility Engineering Associates (FEA) to enhance the existing SI Facilities Management Maintenance Plan by providing assistance with innovative strategic analyses and benchmarks. FEA and GSI have established a Partnership with the Smithsonian to gather various data in order to complete accurate asset inventories, develop maintenance job plans in support of the existing SI Reliability-Centered Maintenance (RCM) program, and populate the existing SI CAFM system. GSI's specific responsibilities as part of the SI team include formatting of asset and RCM data for loading into Smithsonian's CAFM program Facility Center 8i (FC8i), preparation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for use by SI management to load and maintain FC8i data, preparation of training manuals and presentation of classes for SI management and maintenance personnel. The scope of this project includes museums, research centers and storage/support facilities located primarily in Washington, DC, Maryland and New York.
